Annual Goals

- ▶ Annual Reports for Distribution, Transmission and LNG
 - ▶ NSFM will review your submitted reports for completeness and if errors are found we will contact you to submit a supplemental.
- ▶ Annual Inspections ie. Field, OQ9, Construction
 - ▶ NSFM will perform field inspections annually.
 - ▶ BHE – Fourteen units means at least fourteen of these each year.
 - ▶ NWE– Three units means at least three of these each year.(G.I., Kearney, N.P.)
 - ▶ NCU – Four unit means at least four of these each year.(Syracuse, Dunbar, Unadilla, NC)
 - ▶ MUD – Four units means at least four of these each year.(Florence, Bellevue, Millard, Bennington)
 - ▶ MUD LNG field will also be performed annually as long as construction continues.
 - ▶ MEC – Even though you have Dakota City and South Sioux City we will more than likely get into both when we are there.
 - ▶ Municipalities – It is just your town when we are there.

 - ▶ Typically, will now be associated with O&M Inspections.

- ▶ Cast Iron
- ▶ Failure Investigations (Root Cause on excavation Damages)
