- You will have one hour and thirty minutes to complete the exam. All cell phones must be turned off and put away in a pocket or purse prior to testing. An applicant may automatically fail the exam and be dismissed from testing if their phone is not properly stored away, or if they are suspected of cheating.
- The test is open-book. Applicants are expected to come prepared and bring their own copies of the above listed study materials. No notepads, computer, or other electronic devices may be used. The State Fire Marshal's office will NOT provide applicants study materials at the time of testing. Proctors and members of the staff will not take questions or discuss answers with applicants.
- An applicant who fails the first test may apply to retake the exam at no additional cost. If you fail the test a second time, you will need to wait a six-month grace period before re-applying. The \$100 application fee is due at the time of reapplication.
- Applicants who are NICET II-certified or above may receive their license using this certification rather than sitting for the exam. Simply mail a completed application along with the **ORIGINAL** [citizen attestation form](#), copy of your NICET II or above certificate, and \$25 for each year the NICET certification is valid to:
