GENERAL INFORMATION:

Beginning January 1, 1986, every owner or operator of any permanently located aboveground storage tank used to store or dispense hazardous substances is required to register such tank with the State Fire Marshal.

Storage tanks of one thousand gallons (1,000) or less are exempt from this requirement.

Hazardous substances are defined in Subsection 14 of Section 101 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 as it existed on January 1, 1985, but not including any substance regulated as a hazardous waste under Subtitle C of such act (list is available through the State Fire Marshal's office). Anhydrous ammonia is excluded from this list.

Registration forms are available from the State Fire Marshal's office. The registration fee is ten dollars (\$10.00) per tank. Fee is payable on submission of the form to the State Fire Marshal. Payment may be made by check or money order. Remit to State Fire Marshal. Cash is not accepted.

Any change in information contained on this form will require re-registration of the tank. Re-registration of tanks shall require an additional fee of ten dollars(\$10.00).
