



## Nebraska State Fire Marshal Official Application for Permit to Burn a Building

“28-506 Lawful burning of property/training and safety promotion purposes/permit. Property may be lawfully destroyed by burning such structures as condemned by law, structures no longer having any value for habitation or business or no longer serving any useful value in the area in which situate, and any other combustible material that will serve to be used for test fires to educate and train members of organized fire departments and promote fire safety anywhere in Nebraska. Before any structure may be destroyed by fire for training and educational purposes, it must be reported to the State Fire Marshal and a permit issued for that purpose. Any expense incurred in burning a structure shall be assumed by the organized fire department requesting this type of training for members of its department.”

Fire chief and firefighters, before departing from fire scene, <b>SHALL</b> and <b>MUST</b> extinguish <b>ALL</b> embers very thoroughly to prevent rekindling.</p>

1. Return original application, copy of application, and notarized affidavit to:

2. Legal affidavit of ownership MUST be signed by all owners BEFORE a Notary Public and be forwarded to this office BEFORE the State Fire Marshal can approve the burning permit.
3. Permission to burn will be granted ONLY to the chief of the local fire department and only AFTER written application is APPROVED by the State Fire Marshal in writing.
4. Burning permit must be in hands of local fire chief BEFORE burning exercise is conducted.
5. Fire Department and/or owner shall assume all liability for damage which might occur due to this burning exercise.
6. Do not burn if it is windy or property to be burned is close to another person's building
7. Fire chief and firefighters, before departing from fire scene, SHALL and MUST extinguish ALL embers very thoroughly to prevent rekindling.
