- ◆ You will be allowed one and one-half (1½) hours to complete the test. This time limit will be strictly enforced.

- ◆ All **cells phones** must be turned off and in a pocket, purse, or phone holder on belt until after you are out of the testing area. Any phone that is not turned off and secured during the test will constitute an automatic failure of the test.

- ◆ The test will be open-book. Only the above listed study material may be used during the test. No notepads, computer or other electronic devices may be used.

- ◆ Applicants are not permitted to share books or confer with others during the test.

- ◆ Note taking during the test is prohibited.

- ◆ Members of the State Fire Marshal's staff will not discuss test questions or answers with applicants.

- ◆ If you fail the test the second time and must wait the six-month grace period, you may take the test in the month the grace period ends even if the date is earlier than the date indicated for your grace period to end.

- ◆ **NICET II certified or above**, if you would like to receive your license using this certification instead of taking the test:
You must send in a completed application and citizen attestation form along with a **copy** of your NICET II or above certificate and the fee of \$25 per year the NICET II or above certification is valid. The expiration date on your license will coincide with the expiration date of your NICET II or above certification.
